Early Civil Rights Legislation:

- 1. Civil Rights Act of 1957 (pg. 439)
 - Created the U.S. Civil Rights Commission investigated and responded to voter discrimination
 - Gave the Attorney General the power to require federal courts to issue orders to prevent any interference with a person's right to vote.
- 2. Civil Rights Act of 1960 Created federal voting referees who helped correct conditions to prevent voter discrimination.
