Early Civil Rights Legislation:

1. Civil Rights Act of 1957 (pg. 439)

-
- Created the U.S. Civil Rights Commission – investigated and responded to voter discrimination
- Gave the Attorney General the power to require federal courts to issue orders to prevent any interference with a person's right to vote.

2. Civil Rights Act of 1960 – Created federal voting referees who helped correct conditions to prevent voter discrimination.
